

### Real men go to barbers

Donnie Hawley opened his iconic men-only barber shop in 1999 as a place for a guy to get a good haircut, a shave and a little man time.

At the time, Hawleywood's Barber Shop in Costa Mesa was unique among the scores of unisex mall walk-in cutteries and female-dominated salons. These days, there are parlors all over dedicated to serving male grooming needs, but Hawley is a legend in the business, appearing in a 2012 Morgan Spurlock documentary, "Mansome".

An oil-and-canvas depiction of him by artist Mark Cummings hangs at the Smithsonian as part of a portrait competition exhibition. He's also collaborated with skate shoemaker Vans on a signature line and has line

of men's grooming products called 'Layrite,' which he will launch in Ireland in June. He has four shops (three in Orange County and one in Sydney, Australia) and plans to open in Harajuku, Japan, Las Vegas and Canada.

Recently Hawley, 40, took time to answer our questions:

#### Q. How did you get into the barbering business?

A. I started cutting hair at 12 when I moved in with my dad. My uncle had a barbershop so there was always a chair on the back patio. When I was 13, my cousin was on the high school football team and they all got Mohawks one summer before the season. I was able to join in on doing a few. In high school I'd also cut and style my friends hair before we would go out. From that moment I realized I had a knack and talent for cutting hair.

#### Q. Why is it important for the well-groomed man to have a place like Hawleywood's?

**A.** It gives men the opportunity to unwind, relax, have a beer, get a hot towel shave and a Hawleywood's signature cut. While getting pampered you get to listen to a collection of old, rare retro tunes and vinyl.

#### Q. What does Hawleywood's offer that some of the newer men's grooming salons do not?


A. First of all, I've spent my career traveling the world over, educating people on the difference between barbering and cosmetology. In beauty colleges you spend hours learning how to color hair, do makeup and nails etc. In barber college, your only focus is on hot towel shaves and men's haircuts done properly. This includes tapers, high-and-tights, flat tops etc.

At Hawleywood's you get a cut by a licensed, trained real barber. You get hot towels, the smell of bay rum, Playboy magazines, ice cold Pabst and gentlemen-only banter and jokes. There is a certain mythology to the Hawleywood's Barbershop experience that is quite beautiful. Once a patron and a Hawleywood's barber relationship is forged, it will outlast friendships and some of the strongest marriages.

#### Q. The straight razor shave seems to be a big trend these days, why do you think that is?

A. Because I brought it back from the dead through all my travelling and being in countless magazines and shows, it has inspired a lot of people to starts straight razor shaving. I've had customers come in one day and enlist as barber apprentices the next day!

Q. What is the difference between straight razors from the past and straight razors used today?



#### Q. Is there a particularly popular beard or mustache style your clientele prefers?

A. A lot of people are growing beards nowadays due to TV shows and media so I've been working a long while on my beard balm and mustache wax. Most popular request these days are Rollie Fingers-style (or handlebar) mustache and biker beards.

COSTA MESA it's the rare moment when a can of Pabst and a straight edge work well together.

But peek through the window of Hawleywood's Barber Shop in Costa Mesa, and you'll see old-school beers and old-school razors forming a rare but nice harmony. You'll see Donnie Hawley in there too. He's the co-owner, the guy talking and shaving and styling and generally breathing life into a business that could double as a clubhouse or movie set or, you know, a barber shop.

#### Remember those? Barber shops?

That's Hawleywood's. It's a place with barbers who are proud to be barbers. It's also got girlle magazines and cussing and dudes getting haircuts from dudes with the goal of looking like dudes, circa 1957. Walk inside and, if you're cool enough (and, yes, you probably are), you'll get a free beer, a.k.a. "The Hawley's Discount."

What you won't find at Hawleywood's – which celebrated its 10th anniversary last month – is a salon. The word, in fact, might be the only forbidden word in the place.

The other word might be "unisex."

Hawley, 37, doesn't do unisex.

"It's a man's sanctuary," says a very unapologetic Hawley.

"in the 21st century, everything is geared toward to women."

Hawley continues on the topic for a bit, noting the rise of women-only salons and gyms like Curves, before concluding: "There's no place to just go and be a man."

So, at this shop, even moms who bring junior around for a cut have to wait outside.

Hawley says women in a barber shop can be a distraction. They tend to offer the barbers advice on how to cut their man's hair. Besides, Hawley adds, women in the shop just changes the vibe.

"Nobody looks cool in the middle of a haircut."

But cool is exactly how Hawleywood's looks and feels. Johnny Cash (Sun Records era) and Eddie Cochran and other rockabiliy icons serve up a sort of permanent soundtrack. Indeed, the rockability scene that sparked on the streets of Memphis in the '50s and found a revival in early 1980s Britain before settling into full-time life in places like the industrial districts of Costa Mesa and tracts of old town Orange, is in full swing at this shop. A host of living, breathing, hairgrowing rockabilly legends, guys like the Stray Cats bassist Lee Rocker, can often be found sitting and sipping and chatting at Hawleywood's."It's just real music," says Hawley as he strums an imaginary upright bass, the key, he adds, to the heartbeat of rockabilly. But the scene goes deeper than music. The scent of Barbasol permeates the shop, rising with the buzzing and snipping sounds of electric razors and active scissors. Customers sit in barber chairs with builtin ash trays (take that, health nuts) and a few opt for straight razor shaves, reclining with towels around their face like murder victims in a Godfather movie. The barbers at Hawleywood's wear ties and vests. When they're done, they fold their smocks over their chairs; neatly. Customers almost always get a warm embrace from Hawley who greets them like old high school buddles."It's just about gentlemen," Hawley explains. "You could be sitting next to a doctor, a cop, a convict. It's regular Joes."Customers sit in vintage chairs reading girlle and hot rod magazines. And if anyone wants an upfront look at a perfect 1953 Pontiac, they'll find one sitting right outside. On most days, in fact, the front parking lot looks like a vintage car show. The feeling at Hawleywood's runs deeper than style. For many customers, getting a cut evokes childhood days of grooming with fathers and grandfathers, a bond that, many say, can't happen when dad and son swing into Supercuts. "It's just a memory of how simple life was," says Steve Gambill, 45, of Costa Mesa. He's been working on the Pontiac in the front for 15 years. "(It's about) how people appreciated things like a good haircut. Today, everything is so rushed."Ben Frank, 29, who works as an LA deputy sheriff and stops by the shop twice a month for a trim and to talk shop about his 1954 Pontiac and his 1949 Chevy. "Most of the time," he says, "we're just sitting around, talking about cars, having a good time."And when the haircut is

done Hawley has found a way to keep the party going. There's a lounge behind the large bookcase in the back, shifting the relaxation thing into a different gear. There, members of the shop's VIP club can hit the Pabst keg with their own beer mug and watch a game on a large screen television or listen to a small trio on the mini stage, or just shoot a game of pool while cranking up the jukebox. Still, haircuts are the main act and are treated like works of art. "When you look good, you feel good," Hawley says. "And everything else just happens." Hawley says the shop, the haircuts, the music - it all reminds him of growing up around his heroes, people like his grandfather, a legendary motorcycle racer, and his father. And his place - the whole scene, really - started with a song. As a kid, Hawley picked up a Robert Gordon album of rockabilly covers at the now defunct retailer, Gemco. His curiosity about the originals on that album led him to discover America's first rock and rollers.Meanwhile, a barber chair in Hawley's backyard led to early high school haircutting. His first customers were football players in search of Mowhawks. Later, he'd do up his buddles' hair before they'd all go clubbing. After immersing himself in the scene - including the obligatory body ink - Hawley found his niche when he entered barber college."I couldn't do anything else better."Hawley insists the scene at his shop is no gimmick."This is me. Everyday. It's my life."He jokes that his friends often tell him this: "I was born too late."

Women want their cake and eat it too. Let guys have something to their own, with out you having to be there.


