**Statement of Gloria Allred Regarding Huth v. Cosby**

We went to court this morning. Mr. Cosby has hired new lawyers to represent him in our case, Huth v. Cosby in place of the Liner firm. They asked that the trial date of July 30, 2018 in our case be continued to Dec. 3, 2018. The Court continued the case to that date. The Court also set a date of April 19, 2018 for us to return to update him on the outcome of the second criminal trial involving Mr. Cosby.
