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After reading Mr. Cosby's statements in the deposition, I am surprised that he says that he doesn't remember me. I saw and spoke to Mr. Cosby for weeks and weeks at the health club I worked at in Las Vegas. He played tennis there. He even called my mother's home and talked to her and her sister that was visiting from Texas. It was the highlight of my aunt Vida's vacation, talking to the famous Bill Cosby. He was wanting me to come to his show. I was a masseuse at that health club and he wanted me to work on his shoulders and back. He was sore from playing tennis, he kept telling me.

I was at my sister's home years later after he drugged and sexually assaulted me, and I told her what had happened to me. That was around 1986. Up until then, I hadn't told anyone about what had happened to me. I was embarrassed by it all.

My roommates at the time of the assault, were the ones that found me in my car after Mr. Cosby secretly drugged me. I was unconscious and my roommates were unable to wake me. They carried me into our house. I didn't wake up until the next evening.

Sometime in 1995, my husband was changing channels on TV when he

stopped on a channel that was broadcasting "The Bill Cosby Show". I started crying uncontrollably and I told him what had happened. Then a similar situation happened at a friend/clients house for an appointment. She was going to have her daughter watch a Cosby show. I told her that he is not the nice wholesome person that he portrays on his show. I told her that I met him at the club, (she belonged to the same health club), and that he drugged and sexually assaulted me.

I then heard about the Constand vs Cosby case in 2005. That was the first time that I went public with my statement. I was Jane Doe #11. That same year I told another friend about being drugged and raped by Bill Cosby. Her name is Diane. I didn't tell anyone for a long time, only a few close friends and family.

The betrayal of trust from this famous celebrity was so traumatic. I thought, who would believe me, that Bill Cosby was a serial rapist that used drugs to assault unsuspecting young women?
