<u>Statement of Gloria Allred regarding the victory today in the civil lawsuit brought</u> <u>against Alec Baldwin by the mother, father and sister of Halyna Hutchins</u>

Today is a win for Halyna's family. At today's hearing in our civil case, the Court affirmed the obvious – that grieving families have a right to pursue loss of consortium damages related to the death of their loved one under New Mexico law – which will be enforced in California courts against Baldwin and *Rust* producers. Based on today's ruling, we embrace the opportunity to amend our complaint to provide more facts regarding the truth, that the relationships between Halyna and her family have always been the kind of sufficiently close and mutually beneficial relationships recognized under the law of New Mexico. Statements made on behalf of Alec Baldwin by his attorneys¹ in an attempt to dismiss the legal claims of Halyna's mother, father and sister that Halyna's family had been "distanced from Halyna" for years before he shot and killed her are both shameful and wholly unsubstantiated. We are confident that the Court will recognize the tremendous loss of Halyna's parents and sister caused by his killing of Halyna on October 21, 2021.
